

## HHBC Campbell Co. Impact

- 1) Food Pantry serves between 350 and 375 families per month.  
Provided 300 families with complete Thanksgiving dinner annually.
- 2) HHBC serves as a polling place.
- 3) HHBC is the family reunification center in the case of a school emergency.
- 4) HHBC is an emergency site for the Red Cross
- 5) Clothes Closet provided all types of clothing for thousands of families and individuals.  
Special emphasis each August providing 100 backpacks filled with supplies for school children.  
Special emphasis each November to distribute over 100 winter coats annually.
- 6) Take My Hand Ministry provided furniture and housewares for families in need. Served an average of 25 families a month.
- 7) Counseling Center provides free clinical counseling for anyone in our community. Meeting with an average of 25 clients a month.
- 8) Host county events like Rustburg HS baccalaureate and Campbell Co. teacher training events.
- 9) Provide access for training in our facilities for local volunteer fire departments.
- 10) Children's Ministry has been a long-time supporter of CC teachers and staff at elementary schools with special gifts and recognition.
- 11) Student Ministry has supported CC schools athletics by feeding the Football, Wrestling, Cheerleading, Cross Country and Volleyball teams at both Rustburg and Brookville schools.
- 12) Between the Preschool at Hyland Heights and our partnership with Onward Christian Academy, we bring about 300 additional families at least twice a week to our campus and along the 29S. highway. They are purchasing food and gas as they travel.
