## Mission:

- Attend at least one Board of Supervisors meeting during the year.
- Promote the Campbell County Youth Advisory Council in schools and community.
- Work to raise the consciousness of youth issues in the Campbell County area.
- Participate in youth awareness and fundraising activities.

# What is the Meeting Set-up?




Each month the council will learn the needs of the community, local non-profits that meet those needs, local service-driven organizations, event-planning skills, leadership skills, and recognition for their service.
