The purpose of this public hearing is to receive public comment on the proposed Secondary Six-Year Plan for Fiscal Years 2008-09 through 2013-14 in Campbell County, and on the Secondary System Construction Budget for Fiscal Year 2008 - 09. Copies of the proposed Plan and Budget may be reviewed at the County Administrator's Office, Rustburg, Virginia or at the Appomattox Residency Office of the Virginia Department of Transportation, 331 Ferguson Street, Appomattox, Virginia. Requests for Improvements and New Additions will also be considered at this meeting.

All projects in the Secondary Six-Year Plan that are eligible for federal funds will be included in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), which documents how Virginia will obligate federal transportation funds.
