BACKGROUND:

The Campbell County Community Policy Management Team (CPMT) currently has a vacancy for a private provider representative.

DISCUSSION:

The CPMT has nominated Lindsey Tibbs to serve on the CPMT as a private provider representative to replace Cathy Truxell who has recently resigned. Ms. Tibbs is a Therapist and owner of a Campbell County business called “Innovative Family Consultants”. Ms. Tibbs has been providing in home therapeutic services to youth and families for 7 years and has been a supervisor for 5 years. She holds a Masters degree in Marriage and Family Therapy from Liberty University. Ms. Tibbs lives at 3694 White Road in Forest, Virginia.

Traditionally the Board of Supervisors appoints new members to the CPMT.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Board appoint Lindsey Tibbs to serve as a private provider representative on the Campbell County Community Policy Management Team (CPMT) effective January 27, 2010.

CPMT members are reappointed by the Board of Supervisors every two years.
