**Subject:** Boxley's Flat Creek Quarry Update

I am writing to share some of the upcoming tasks Boxley will be undertaking at the Flat Creek site in fulfillment of the commitments we made to the Campbell County Board of Supervisors and the Evington Community last year.

As outlined in our Groundwater Protection Plan that was submitted to the Campbell County Board of Supervisors, Boxley established an independent escrow fund in the amount of \$50,000 for any fees related to well issues, due to the quarry development. Rest assured this escrow account still exists and Boxley is committed to the terms as outlined in the agreement. The next deposit will be made in four years. We also outlined in that plan our intention to drill independent monitoring wells on site and to publish the data on the internet for anyone interested in the water levels of these wells. We intend to place these wells on the Flat Creek property in the 1st Quarter of 2010. Once the wells are in place, we would also like to establish our independent team and will be working with Campbell County officials and the ECA to pick an individual who will be willing to assist in monitoring the wells with our Boxley representative.

Additionally, we are starting to discuss conceptual plans for the berms and landscaping on the property. We will assess the permits required and start the submittal process with the required regulatory agencies for this activity. Once a conceptual plan is complete, I would like to present our thoughts to the ECA in hopes of gaining an understanding of the work to be performed and to receive your feedback on issues that may concern you with our plan. The goal would be to have a mutually agreeable plan before we start earthmoving. I would expect the berm and landscaping work to be started in the 2nd or 3rd quarter of 2010, with the goal of having it completed by this time next year.

Many have asked me whether the current economic conditions will delay the move from Lawyers Road to Flat Creek. Although this is a difficult question, the answer is not yet. Although we have not sold, and therefore not depleted, the reserves at Lawyers Road as fast this

year as in past years, the slowdown in sales only gains a few months longer, not years. Therefore it is still our estimate that we will have the Flat Creek quarry open in approximately 14 years.

We have enjoyed working with the Evington Community Association during the past year and look forward to being an active and responsible neighbor in the future. I hope each of you has a safe and happy Holiday season. If you should have any questions, please do not hesitate to call.
