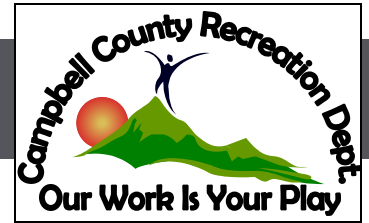

Teach Your Children Compassion

Yes, I have said things like "that person is missing the gene for compassion". Experience now tells me that the environment one grows up in has the larger impact on whether or not the person develops empathy, compassion, and basic values. Genuine concern for the welfare of others is actually a skill that can be nurtured.

Parents can make a conscious effort to show empathy. We call it "walking the walk". I followed the 80-20 rule (80% praise, 20% constructive criticism, 0% destructive criticism). In addition to teaching my sons to say "thank you", I routinely had them write thank you notes. Their "feelings" vocabulary was always an important part of their overall vocabulary. We emphasized words like "happy" and "sad". Discussions, especially at the dinner table, were helpful. "Why is she so sad?" "What can we do to make her feel better?" "What makes him happy?"

Tolerance and respect play a major role in compassion. Celebrate differences. Know that absolute colorblindness is not a reality. Silence can be a bigger problem than ethnic comments. I always chose my own input over having my kids fill in the blanks, and I am proud of the results. Social skills, like compassion, are an integral part of kindergarten readiness and life preparation. I suggest that if a 5 year-olds favorite word is still "mine", he or she may require a little more preparation to be successful in school.

Community Information

Citizens Encouraged to Take Preparedness Measures for Natural Incidents and Other Emergencies

As Campbell County takes an all-hazards approach to preparedness, citizens are encouraged to take precautions for not only severe weather, but likewise for any emergencies that may arise. Strong winds, heavy precipitation, flash flooding, possible power outages and other incidents may occur at any time throughout the year. Thus, citizens are reminded to take the following safety steps:

PRIOR TO SEVERE WEATHER/OTHER EMERGENCY INCIDENTS:

- Obtain the recommended three day supply of water (3 gallons per person)
- Prepare essential items in advance, such as special dietary needs, hygiene items, medications, clothing, cash and copies of important documents such as birth certificates and social security cards.
- Fully charge cell phones, computers and mobile devices
- Check on any neighbors who may need assistance; ensure pets' needs are met
- Create a family emergency plan/emergency contact list; note phone numbers of family members, neighbors and physicians. An online template is available at: <http://www.vaemergency.gov/ReadyVirginia/MakeAPlanForm>.
- Monitor local conditions and stay tuned to local media for updates; keep apprised of possible evacuation notices and the opening/location of any emergency shelters.
