
Re: Virginia Pollution Abatement (VPA) Permit for Land Application of Biosolids; Campbell County, Virginia

Dear Mr. Laurrell:

Upon receipt of an application for a Virginia Pollution Abatement (VPA) permit to land apply biosolids in Virginia, § 62.1-44.19:3.4 of the Code of Virginia requires the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) to notify the locality of the permit application. This is to inform you that the DEQ has received an application for a VPA permit from Nutri-Blend, Inc. The applicant proposes to manage the land application of biosolids to farmland in Campbell County without a discharge to surface waters, in accordance with the VPA Regulation, 9 VAC 25-32.

The Department will review the application and then schedule a public meeting in Campbell County to discuss the technical issues relating to the proposed pollutant management activity. Notice of the meeting will appear in *The News and Advance* inviting the public to attend.
