

The Fray Family Charitable Trust Scholarship

Student Scholarships

PURPOSE:

The scholarship was established to provide financial assistance to up to two (2) students from each Campbell County High School, two from the home school community and two from a private school who plans to further his/her education (i.e. technical school, community college, four-year college).

FUNDING:

Funding for the student scholarships is provided by The Fray Family Charitable Trust. Up to twelve (12) \$5,000 scholarships (two from each high school, home school and private school) will be awarded to the applicants who best meet the stated criteria. Each scholarship recipient will receive a certificate of the award. A check in the amount of \$5,000 will be mailed to the institution to be attended.

ELIGIBILITY:

Eligible students must be a resident of Campbell County and graduating from a Campbell County High School, a home school or private school. Any student applying for a scholarship must be entering college in the fall semester following high school graduation.

Attached is the application form. High School students should return the application to the High School Counselors Office. Applications from a home school or a private school should be completed and returned to Catherine Moore, Secretary of the Trust, by **March 31, 2026** by mailing to P. O. Box 442, Rustburg, Virginia 24588 or by e-mail to chmoore@campbellcountyva.gov.

Scholarships awarded will be based on the following criteria:

- Scholastic achievement (minimum 2.0 GPA)
- Financial need – **Must provide one of the following:**
Free Application for Federal Student Aid – FAFSA, most recent Family 1040 Form or Direct Certification Approval for Benefits – free and reduced lunch verification letter.
- Community involvement
- Recommendations (three)

PROCEDURE:

The applicant must complete the application and return it along with a high school transcript, Student Aid Report (if the institution requires FAFSA), and supporting letters of recommendation by **March 31, 2026**. The applications would be reviewed by the full Board of Trustees. The student would be notified of the award.
